Provisional Affiliation to new Engineering College i.e.Satya College of Engineering & Technology,Vill.Mitrol,Tehsil Hodal,Distt.Faridabad for B.Tech.Course from the session 2008-09.

Dear Sir.

Kindly refer to your proposal regarding establishment of Satya College of Engineering & Technology, Vill. Mitrol, Tehsil Hodal, Distt. Faridabad on the above noted subject.

2. On the basis of the report of the Inspection Committee which visited your proposed institute on 6.7.2008 to verify the various infrastructural facilities provided for running B.E. Course, the Vice-Chancellor has been pleased to grant provisional affiliation to the said Engineering Institute i.e. Satya College of Engineering & Technology, Vill. Mitrol, Tehsil Hodal, Distt. Faridabad for starting B. Tech. Ist year (4 year degree course) in the following branches (as per approval by the AICTE vide letter No.06/04/HR-Engg/2008/74 dated 19.6.2008) from the session 2008-09 in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council/Executive Council and the decision of the Academic Council/Executive Council and the Institute:

1. Electronics & Comm. Engg., : 60 seats
2. Computer Sc. Engg. : 60 seats
3. Electrical Engg. : 60 seats
4. Information Technology : 60 seats

- 3. The above provisional affiliation is subject to fulfillment of all the observations/shortcomings pointed out by the Inspection Committee in its report dated 6.7.2008.
- 4. The above provisional affiliation is further subject to the following mandatory conditions:
 - 1. The Institute shall constitute Governing Body as per AICTE/University norms.
 - 2. The admissions will not exceed beyond the sanctioned intake.
 - 3. The teaching and other staff shall be appointed through the properly constituted Selection Committees and with prior approval of the University as per University Norms. CPF scheme must be introduced. Service rules for teaching/non-teaching staff should be framed and a copy be sent to the University.
 - 4. The Faculty shall be appointed as per AICTE norms in the pay scales prescribed by it from time to time
 - 5. The fee structure prescribed by the State Govt./University shall be strictly followed.
 - 6. All Academic-physical and other infrastructural facilities shall be continued to be provided/upgraded by the institute as prescribed by the AICTE/University from time to time.
 - 7. The institute shall furnish requisite documents and reports as called for by the University from time to time in order to ensure proper maintenance of the infrastructural facilities and academic standards.
 - 8. The information furnished in respect of above courses shall be factual and correct. In the event of any information found to be false, misleading or suppressed the provisional affiliation shall be withdrawn by the University without any notice.
 - 9. In the event of non compliance of the University Act/Statutes/Ordinances/Rules & Regulations and any other instructions/guidelines issued from time to time, the University shall be free to withdraw the provisional affiliation and all liabilities arising out of such a withdrawal would solely lie on the concerned society/institute.
 - 10. The institute shall follow the mode of selection of candidates for admissions as approved by the State Govt/University.

11. The institute shall provide all academic and infrastructural facilities including classrooms, hostels, library, laboratories, workshops, play grounds and other amenities required for the smooth conduct of its affairs as per AICTE/University norms.

12. <u>Building</u>: The entire building of the college will be at the disposal of the Controller of Examinations for the purpose of conduct of examinations as and when, the Centre of Examination (for theory and practical both) is created it will be obligatory for the Principal to

provide necessary infrastructure for smooth conduct of examination.

13. Examination Centre: Creation of an Examination Centre in the college will be at the discretion of the Controller of Examinations. The center of examinations for the students studying in the College can be shifted to any other college. In such a situation, it will be the responsibility of the Institution to make arrangements for transporting the students to the Centre of Examinations without any extra charges from the students. Similarly, the University can also shift the students of other colleges/institutes to the college/institution under reference for which necessary infrastructure will have to be provided by the Principal concerned.

14. <u>Staff:</u> For the purpose of conduct of examinations, the services of entire teaching & non-teaching staff will be at the disposal of the Controller of Examinations. The examination duties can be assigned to any member of teaching and non-teaching staff which will have to be complied with, in the interest of smooth conduct of examinations.

15. <u>Strong Room</u>: There will be a Strong Room in the college at the prime location-adjacent to the office of the Principal to keep the confidential material of the University as and when

required. The Strong Room will essentially have double lock system.

You are requested to complete the above requirements/conditions and send compliance report of the same to the University so that further action as demanded of us may be taken accordingly. In case of non compliance of above conditions/requirements, the University shall have the right to refuse the extension in provisional affiliation to the institute for the next academic session. A copy of the ordinance pertaining to affiliation of colleges/institutions is attached herewith.

Inspection Report of

SATYA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY, Vill – Mitrol, Tehsil – Hodal, Distt. Faridabad

The inspection committee comprising of Prof. D. R. Goyal, Prof. P. V. Gupta, Prof. A. K. Sharma and Mrs. Sarla Chahal visited the proposed SATYA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY, Vill – Mitrol, Tehsil – Hodal, Distt. Faridabad, on 06.07.08 to verify the requisite infrastructural facilities and other support system for grant of provisional affiliation for starting B.Tech degree courses in four disciplines i.e. CSE, ECE, EE and IT with an intake of 60 seats each at the first year level. The committee visited the site and inspected the class rooms, laboratories, workshops, library and other infrastructure and has the following observations:

CB-2849

The Institute is situated on NH-2, 13 Km from Palwal, close to ACME and has a land 10.16 acre in the name of society. The Institute has constructed 3776 Sqm area having lower ground, ground, first floor and second floor with sufficient number of lecture halls, seminar rooms, drawing hall, conf. Halls, laboratories, workshops, library, computer centre and administrative office etc. The internal approach road is complete while the external approach road is partially completed.

The computer lab consists of 60 computers and 6 printers and also has 512 kBPs internet connection and the required software i.e. MSDN subscription. A website (www.satyaedu.ac.in) of the Institute has been developed and hosted.

The lecture halls, labs, workshops are equipped with necessary furniture. The college has installed the required equipment in the Physics, Chemistry, Electrical and Mechanical labs and workshops.

The library has 5008 books with 1210 titles.

The HSEB has provided a power line to the college with sanctioned load 49.5 KVA and there is also a backup of 62 KVA Gen Set.

Hostel for both boys and girls have been identified at Palwal, the nearby town. The Institute has been advised to arrange for proper transportation for the students and the staff.

The college has identified professors and faculty members. The director principal has also been appointed with the qualifications as per AICTE.

In view of the above observations, the committee recommends for the grant of provisional affiliation for the year 2008-2009.
